TECHNOLOGY USE

This section outlines the guidelines and expectations relating to the use of technology owned by the School Board of Alachua County.

- I understand I am responsible for all actions taken by my child while using this device. The device is complete with a CIPA compliant filter that meets the legal filtering requirements for students. The CIPA compliant filter is available and active. The following list of categories will be blocked: pornography, nudity, gambling, anonymizer, phishing/fraud, spam/spyware. With or without the filter, the parent/guardian remains responsible for monitoring their student's online activities while using this device.
- I will ensure that while using this device, my student follows the Code of Student Conduct, which prohibits:
 1. Sending messages using a false identity or using the accounts of others to send messages.
 2. Accessing the control panel on a district computer, or attempting to modify settings in any way.
 3. Stealing or destroying the school's technology.
 4. Violating or attempting to violate the security of the computer network.
 5. Taking actions (whether successful or not) to by-pass the District's filter, or to deny access, disrupting, or destroying the service of the computer network.
 6. Using district technology resources for illegal purposes or any other activity prohibited by District policy.
 7. Using technology in a way to threaten, humiliate, harass, embarrass or intimidate another person.
 8. Knowingly distributing any materials that are obscene or harmful to others, as defined in section 847.012, Florida Statutes.
