COMMUNITY

Santa Fe High School is located within the Alachua County Public School District and is located 16 miles north of Gainesville in the heart of Alachua County. A rural school serving 1,237 students, Santa Fe serves a warm and caring "small town" community with strong values of education, community service, and leadership.

CURRICULUM

Santa Fe High School follows a 6 period schedule. Students may earn 6 credits per year. Courses are classified into one of the following areas: *Advanced Placement, Honors, Core, Elective, or Special Education*. Career and Technology Education is offered through our Biotechnology Magnet Program as well as our Agriscience and Veterinary Technician Magnet Programs. These Magnet programs serve 3 different career clusters. Students also have the opportunity to dual enroll through Santa Fe College or the University of Florida to earn both high school and college credits.

GRADING, WEIGHT AND RANKING

Santa Fe High School reports the exact class rank using a weighted GPA scale. Grading is on a 4.0 scale with an additional point given to AP and Honors Courses. Valedictorian and Salutatorian are decided by a recalculation of GPA with Honors courses receiving only a .5 additional point and AP courses given a full 1.0 additional point.
