

MINUTES OF THE  
PUBLIC WORKSHOP SESSION FOR  
SCHOOL CONCURRENCY IN ALACHUA COUNTY  
THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR  
PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY PLANNING

May 16, 2006

The Staff Working Group, consisting of staff members of the County, School Board and various Local Governments conducted a Public Input session duly called at 4:30 p.m. in the boardroom, East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida. Present were: Staff Working Group Members; various elected officials; and interested citizens.

The meeting was called to order by Terry Tougaw.

**OVERVIEW**                    The purpose of the workshop was to present to the public the major changes and revisions to the proposed Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning to include School Concurrency

**PRESENTATION**            Mr. Tougaw did an overview of the agenda, handouts, and topic's for the meeting.

Mr. Ken Zeichner, Principal Planner for the County and Mr. Ivey Bell, Senior Planner for the County presented the requirements for school concurrency, the timeline, and the school concurrency process flow chart.

Mr. Tougaw and Mr. Gene Boles, from the University of Florida presented reviewed the major changes to the proposed Interlocal Agreement.
