8. Transportation Bus Use Agreements Githens
- a. This agreement with the University of Florida Athletic Association will provide transportation for the 2007 Gator Golf Camp on June 9, 2007.
 - b. This agreement with the University of Florida Student Government Association will provide transportation for the 2007 Florida Emerging Leaders Conference on February 10, 2007.

9. Innovation Fair Matchmaker Grant Edwards
- A Project Application has been prepared for the Innovation Fair Matchmaker grant. During the October 2006 Innovation Fair, teachers from Buchholz High School Academy of Entrepreneurship were asked to mentor schools in replicating their program. Buchholz teachers mentored five districts (\$10,000 each district) and will be awarded \$50,000 in grant money from the Department of Education to cover the costs of mentoring these schools in the development of the academies.

10. Contract with DES of Florida, LLC (Jan Benet) Longstreth
- DES of Florida provides a means for administrators and professional/technical employees to retire when they complete DROP, but to be subcontracted to SBAC for a period of one year. The SBAC previously signed an umbrella agreement with DES. The Superintendent recommends the return of Jan Benet.

11. Professional Services Gable
- a. Professional Services Ranking for Project SBAC A0603—Gainesville High School Media Center Additions and Renovations

Interviews were conducted on November 30, 2006, for the design professional on this project. It is requested that the School Board accept the following ranking: 1) Long & Associates, Inc., Tampa, Florida; 2) Johnson, Peoples Architects, P.A., Ocala, Florida; 3) Craig Salley & Associates, Architects, Gainesville Florida. Fees for these services will be presented for approval at a later date.
 - b. Professional Services Ranking for Project SBAC A0601—Lincoln Middle School Student Services Additions and Renovations

Interviews were conducted on December 5, 2006, for the design professional on this project. It is requested that the School Board accept the following ranking: 1) Craig Salley & Associates, Architects, Gainesville, Florida; 2) Long & Associates, Inc., Tampa, Florida; 3) The Rickman Partnership, Inc., Gainesville, Florida. Fees for these services will be presented for approval at a later date.
 - c. Construction Management Services for Project SBAC A0505—Loften High School New Classroom and Multi-Purpose Building

It is recommended that the School Board include this project in the current construction management program with PPI Construction Management, Inc., Gainesville, Florida. A Guaranteed Maximum Price for construction will be presented at a later date.

12. Schematic Design Documents for Project SBAC D0232—Santa Fe High School New Classroom Building Gable
- Brame Architects, Gainesville, Florida, has prepared Schematic Design Documents for the construction of this project. It is requested that the School Board approve these plans as presented.
13. Design Development/Construction Documents for Project SBAC A0331—Hawthorne High School Classroom Remodeling, Buildings 8, 9, 10, 11 and 13 Gable
- Johnson, Peoples Architects, P.A., Ocala, Florida, has prepared Design Development/Construction Documents for the construction of this project. It is requested that the School Board approve these plans as presented.
14. Certificate of Final Inspection for Project GFA (Previously Project SBAC S0505-- Hurricane Shelter Retrofits Gable
- This project has been inspected by the project engineer and the facilities department staff. It is requested that the School Board authorize final payment to the contractor upon total acceptance of this project. Final contract amount is \$447,548.80. The amount of this contract was fully reimbursed by the Retrofit Grant from the Florida Department of Community Affairs.
15. Agreement with School-Link Technologies Eunice
- An agreement has been prepared with School-Link Technologies that will enable parents to prepay for meals by using a credit card or debit card. The use of the card would serve as a convenience to increase sales, improve cash flow management, and reduce bad checks.
16. Agreement with the Alachua County Commission on behalf of Healthy Kids Omer
- An agreement has been prepared for Alachua County government to contribute to the Alachua County School Board \$40,000 for Healthy Kids insurance premiums. This program provides an affordable comprehensive health insurance package for school-age children who are not covered by private insurance or Medicaid.
17. Arts in Education Grant Proposal Omer
- A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of State Division of Cultural Affairs, for a competitive Arts in Education grant. This grant will enable Alachua County students to visit the Harn Museum and develop a greater understanding of art. A total of \$10,000 is requested.
18. Enhancing Education Through Technology II Grant Omer
- A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for an Enhancing Education Through Technology II (competitive) grant. These funds will support technology infusion in the learning environment through an extensive program of in-service for teachers and administrators, classroom support in the form of “technology coaches,” development of project-based learning activities, and the purchase of digital equipment for the classroom.

- 19. Florida Learn & Serve—Homeland Security Grant Proposal—Contract Addendum Omer
 Alachua County was granted a budget amendment for an additional \$4,873 in funds under the SPARC Homeland Security grant to offer the Hippodrome State Theatre’s Improvisational Teen Theatre program at the Alachua Regional Juvenile Detention Center (ARJDC). This contract addendum changes the original amount of \$33,863 with the Hippodrome to \$38,736.
- 20. Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Technical Assistance Grant for the Development of a Draft Public School Facility Element for School Concurrency Tougaw
 This subgrant agreement with the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) will provide \$25,000 to the lead agency and is for the purpose of preparing a single, draft public school facility element with all non-exempt local governments, so that they can use it for developing their own element as required by SB 360.

The Interlocal Agreement is a part of a City Commission, County Commission, and School Board partnership to support the Academy of Business Ownership at Loftan High School. The School Board’s responsibility is to provide and support the Academy of Business Ownership. The County Commission is responsible for support and implementation of a mentoring program for these students to begin in the 2007-2008 school year.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board approve the Interlocal Agreement as presented.

9. Resolution No. 06-09—Intent to Participate in Section 212.12, F.S., Classroom Technology Purchases and Training Ward

Sales and use tax filers are entitled to a collection allowance of 2.5 percent of the first \$1,200 amount of tax due (a maximum of \$30) as compensation. The 2006 amendment to Section 212.12, F.S., provides that sales and use tax dealers entitled to a collection allowance may elect to forego the collection allowance and direct the said amount be transferred into the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund (EETF).

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board approve Resolution No. 06-09, Intent to Participate in Section 212.12, F.S., Classroom Technology Purchases and Training, as presented.

APPROVED CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS

- (1) Change Order Number One for Project SBAC B0603 – Ft. Clarke Middle School Lighting Retrofit.

On December 5, 2006, the Superintendent authorized execution of Change Order Number One to the construction contract. This change order deducts \$30,758.75 from the contract, revising the contract total to \$15,221.15 and represents construction material and equipment that will be purchased by the District directly from the manufacturer/supplier at a savings of approximately \$1,922. This change order adds no calendar days to the contract time.

- (2) Change Order Number One for Project SBAC H0603 – J. J. Finley Elementary School Air Conditioning Replacement, Buildings 1,3 and 4 Phase II

On December 11, 2006, the Superintendent authorized execution of Change Order Number One to the construction contract.
