

Lyceum Application Procedures and Dates

Applications for the 2008-09 school year will be available online and in Lincoln's front office in December. The postmark deadline for returning applications to Lincoln is Friday, February 15th, 2008. Applicants must include with their application all of the following:

- 1. a copy of their most recent FCAT (or comparable standardized test) scores. Both NRT (measured in stanines) and CRT (measured from Levels 1-5) sections of FCAT must be included**
- 2. a copy of their 1st semester report card (1st and 2nd nine weeks). This will be the 5th grade report card for those applying for 6th grade Lyceum.**
- 3. a copy of their 4th grade Florida Writing results Assessment**

Applicants who scored 3.5 or higher on the FCAT Writing Test **DO NOT need to write an essay**. Applicants who have never taken this test or who scored 3.0 or lower will need to submit an essay as part of their application. The essay form and instructions are included in the application.

Minimum requirements to apply:

- 3.5 GPA for the 1st semester of 5th grade
- Stanine scores of 7s, 8s, and 9s in math and reading on the most recent FCAT test
- A record of excellent behavior and attendance
