

Interpreting Lexile and Reading Program information in Horizon records

Lexile information

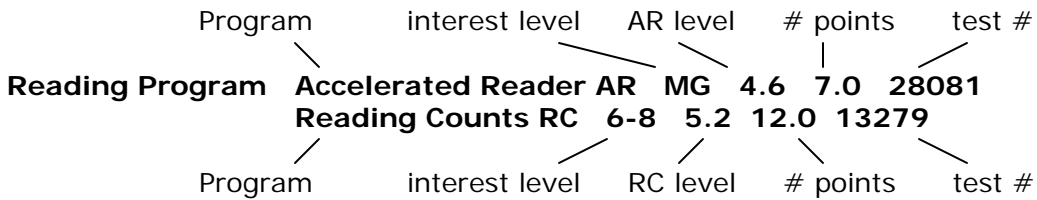
If a Lexile is there you will see a number or some letters then the word Lexile. In your MARC record it will be a 521 tag. If you do not see the word Lexile, it is not a Lexile level; it is only a Vendor interest or reading level.

AR information

This will be a 526 tag with Accelerated Reader AR in the a. subfield. The b. subfield will show the interest level, the c. subfield will show the reading level, the d. subfield will show the AR points, and the z. subfield will show the number of the AR test. Sometimes there is another field which shows where the information came from but you can disregard that.

RC information

This will be a 526 tag with Reading Counts RC in the a. subfield. The b. subfield will show the interest level, the c. subfield will show the reading level, the d. subfield will show the RC points, and the z. subfield will show the number of the RC test. Sometimes there is another field which shows where the information came from but you can disregard that.



For both AR and RC information the test # is additionally displayed in the body of the record with the AR information usually listed first.
