- 1. Practice “The Golden Rule” online.**
- 2. Do not give out personal information or send pictures to a person you only know online. They may not be who you think they are.**
- 3. Tell an adult when someone online makes you feel uncomfortable.**
- 4. Don’t agree to meet someone you only know online. It could actually be a person who means to do you harm.**
- 5. Don’t reply to e-mail messages that make you feel uncomfortable.**
- 6. Don’t give out credit card numbers to anyone.**
- 7. Don’t forward chain letters.**
- 8. Don’t copy music illegally from the internet.**
- 9. E-mail is not private. Do not assume that it is.**
- 10. Don’t download anything without asking your teacher or parent. You may download a virus.**
- 11. If you receive an e-mail asking you to forward something to everyone,....don’t.**
- 12. Don’t tell anyone your account password.**
- 13. Don’t e-mail in UPPERCASE. It’s like shouting.**
