



2009-2010 Title I School Improvement Initiative

The Title I School Improvement Initiative has allocated funds for Title I schools identified as in need of improvement, corrective action or restructuring and Title I schools that failed to meet the State's annual Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) target in reading, math or science.

These funds will be used for:

1. **Materials and Supplies:** Funds will be used to purchase reading, math and science materials. These materials will supplement district adopted texts and other purchased resources
2. **Before and After school Tutoring:** Students who are not eligible to participate in supplemental educational services (SES) and students who are eligible but not able to receive SES do to limited funds, will receive tutoring with funds from this initiative.
3. **Planned Learning Communities (PLCs)/Lesson Studies:** Funds will allow the instructional staff and administration to plan, conduct data chats, perform steps identify in the Florida Continuous Improvement Model (FCIM) activities and to conduct lesson studies.
4. **Professional Development:** Funds will be used for staff to attend workshops, conferences and training activities designed to improve classroom instruction, knowledge and skills
