



Dear Parents,

The 2007 Newberry High School Prom will be from 8:00 P.M. – 12:00 A.M. on April 21, 2007 at the Savannah Grande Ballroom in Gainesville.

Early tickets will be sold for two weeks during February during lunch in the commons area at a cost of \$35.00 each for senior tickets and \$40.00 each for any non-senior guest and all juniors. The early ticket sales will take place on the following dates: February 12, 13, 20, 21, 22 and 23rd. Any tickets not purchased during the discounted time period will be sold for \$50.00. These tickets will be sold on the following dates: March 13, 14, 15, 20, 21 and 22nd. The last day to purchase tickets is March 22nd. No tickets will be sold after this date unless arrangements have been made with Mr. Lovingood before March 22nd. **Any student**, including SFCC Dual Enrollment students, wishing to purchase a ticket, must do so in the aforementioned time frames. Dual Enrollment students may see Mrs. Ward any time during the day to purchase tickets but should call in advance to ensure that she will be on campus. All other students **must** purchase their tickets when Mrs. Ward is in the commons area during lunch. Each student may purchase one guest ticket for a guest that will be attending with him or her. Any guests that are not NHS students must go through an approval process. In order to have a guest approved, a student must fill out an administrative approval form seven working days before purchasing their prom tickets. No guests over the age of 20 or under the age of 15 will be approved to attend the NHS Prom. Please, see Mrs. Ward at anytime for the approval form. The administration has total discretion concerning guests and must approve any student not enrolled in Newberry High.

Guests must have a picture ID with them to check in at the prom. Tickets will be numbered, and selling or giving away tickets is prohibited. **There will be no refunds on tickets.**

In order to attend the prom, a student must be debt free, have no more than two level three infractions, and may have no level four infractions. If a student is on suspension, he or she may not attend the prom. Students who have left Newberry High School and are attending another school for an alternative setting may not attend the prom. It is up to the discretion of the Newberry High's administrators to determine who may attend Newberry's Prom.

We encourage junior parents to be involved and help with the prom decorations. We also need at least fifteen parents to be chaperones. Please email Mr. Lovingood at lovingoodcl@sbac.edu if you are interested in chaperoning or helping out in any other capacity.
