

## **DISTRICT-WIDE EXCLUSIVE BEVERAGE CONTRACT INFORMATION**

1. If your vending machine needs to be re-filled, call 800-647-2653, select option #1, and provide the outlet #, which is located on the face of the machine, when prompted to do so. Turn-around time for machine re-stocking is approximately 2 business days;
2. If your vending machine is not working, call 800-647-2653, select option #2, and provide the outlet # when prompted to do so.
3. If your vending machine has been vandalized, please contact Mr. Dan Baldinelli at 494.1026 immediately.
4. Vending sales commission checks are distributed to all schools **monthly**. If your check is late, please contact Leslie Hugg by phone at 904.838.5127 or by email to [lhugg@cokecce.com](mailto:lhugg@cokecce.com).
5. Each fiscal year, Coke will provide free cases of product as follows:
  - High Schools: 50 Cases, 12 oz Product
  - Middle Schools: 25 Cases, 12 oz Product
  - Elementary Schools: 10 Cases, 12 oz Product

6. Other Points of Interest:
  - Schools receive 25% commission based on net sales of vended 12 oz and 25 oz product
  - Free Product (see item 5 above)
  - Annually, during the first five years of the contract, the District receives a lump sum amount for athletic scoreboard purchases and maintenance. The

District Beverage Committee, which is composed of school principals and district staff, uses these funds to purchase scoreboards for the schools.

- Annually, at the end of the school year, high schools receive a \$1 rebate for each case of product sold (vended) and purchased (boosters, etc.).
- Annually, at the end of each fiscal year, the District receives a \$2 rebate for all cases of product sold/purchased within the District. The District Beverage Committee is then tasked with making recommendations to the Superintendent about how these funds will be used in the schools.
