

Dress Code

Students are expected to be neat, clean, and appropriately dressed for all school activities.

- * Hats or head coverings (including hoods), curlers, and bandanas are prohibited.
- * Articles of clothing should cover the midriff and the upper thigh. Attire which reveals armpits such as tank tops or those with spaghetti straps or which have low necklines is not permitted.
- * The showing of undergarments above the waistline of shorts or pants is not permitted. In other words, sagging is not allowed.
- * All eyeglasses, zippers, buttons, snaps, belts, and other fasteners on articles of clothing must be fastened and worn as meant to be worn.
- * Slippers, sandals, and all open-toed shoes are not permitted.
- * Pajamas are not permitted.
- * No dangerous jewelry (spiked bracelets, necklaces, or collars). Wallet chains are not permitted.
- * Dress promoting drugs, gangs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons, and/or sexual behavior or containing obscene signs, logos, or language is not permitted.
