Board members voiced their appreciation for the recent veterans day activities held in the schools. It was noted that these activities provide students with the opportunities to meet and learn the importance of veterans day.

Mr. Eubank suggested the district look in to updating the antiquated microphone system in the Boardroom in order to enhance the audio quality for viewers at home.

Superintendent Boyd shared information related to the status of class size reduction. He noted the district is in compliance with 4-8 (22), and 9-12 (25), and is currently working on PK-3 (18) figures.
