

MINUTES OF  
THE ELECTED OFFICIALS MEETING FOR THE  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR  
PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY PLANNING

May 18, 2006

The Elected Officials Group—representing the County, School Board, and nine Local Governments, met in workshop session duly called at 1:30 p.m. in the boardroom of the School Board, East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida. Present were: Elected Officials representing nine of the eleven local governments; other elected officials, administrative staff members and members from the public.

The meeting was called to order by School Board Chairman Wes Eubank.

**OVERVIEW**            The purpose of the workshop was to present to the Elected Officials Group to review the major changes to the proposed Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning to include School Concurrency

**PRESENTATION**    Mr. Tougaw did an overview of the agenda and topic's for the meeting.

Mr. Ken Zeichner, Principal Planner for the County and Mr. Ivey Bell, Senior Planner for the County presented the requirements for school concurrency, the timeline, and the school concurrency process flow chart.

Mr. Tougaw and Mr. Gene Boles, from the University of Florida, presented reviewed the major changes to the proposed Interlocal Agreement.

**DISCUSSION**            Discussion from the Elected Officials and the public centered around geographic application of concurrency—districtwide/less-than-districtwide service areas, level of service standards, proportionate share mitigation, school board funding and revenue sources, equity between older schools in the city and newer schools. Also, there were questions by the public and the Elected Officials about the imposed timeline by Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for the revisions to the Interlocal Agreement. The Elected Officials officially requested that staff request an extension to the timeline.
