

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA  
UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF MICANOPY CHARTERED HIGH SCHOOL APPLICATION  
WORKSHOP  
November 6, 2006

The School Board of Alachua County, Florida, met in work group session duly called at 8:00 a.m. in Conference Room E, 620 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida. Present were: F. Wesley Eubank, chairman; Virginia S. Childs, vice-chairman; Tina Pinkoson, Eileen Roy, and Janie S. Williams, members; W. Daniel Boyd, Jr., superintendent; and staff members.

The purpose of the workshop was for the Board to discuss and make comments concerning the application for Micanopy Chartered High School.

After review by district staff members and the Board, it was determined that the application for Micanopy Chartered High School should be amended to include 9<sup>th</sup> graders for the 2007-2008 school year. The Board advised Bobby Johnson, applicant, to revise application to incorporate Micanopy Middle and Micanopy High School. The Board's recommendation was based on start-up costs and the required increase in personnel to sustain the new school. The Board agreed to allow Micanopy Middle Charter School to enroll 9<sup>th</sup> graders for the 07-08 school year and to review revised application for the combination of Micanopy Middle and High school under next year's state mandated deadlines for new charter school applications.

No other workshops were scheduled at this time.
