- 8. Bus Use Agreement..... Githens
- This agreement with the University of Florida will provide transportation for the Women's Softball team on June 18, 2006, through June 22, 2006.

- 9. 2005 Educational Plant Survey with Revisions from the Department of Education..... Gable
- The five-year Educational Plant Survey recommendations and the final survey document have been prepared by district staff and the consultants, School Facility Planners, P.A., with revisions from the Department of Education. It is requested that the Board approve the 2005 Educational Plant Survey as presented.

- 10. Contract with Alachua/Bradford Regional Workforce Board..... Edwards
- This contract provides funding (\$108,000) for two teacher specialists and travel to support the construction programs. One position would be a recruiter who would meet with students, parents and school staff to encourage participation. The other position would be an internship/OJT manager who would set up and supervise student work experiences during the school day and in the summer.

- 11. Tech Prep Articulation Agreement..... Edwards
- This agreement with Santa Fe Community College provides for the students of the Academy of Criminal Justice at Newberry High School to receive advanced credit-standing at Santa Fe Community College on the basis of program completion and successful completion of a competency exam.

- 12. District Technology Plan Utley

This Technology Plan is an update of the district’s existing plan, which expires this year. An updated Technology Plan must be in place and approved by the School Board and the Florida Department of Education in order to receive E-rate funding, and to fulfill the requirements of the E-rate program, prior to the June 30 deadline. The plan describes how information technology and telecommunications infrastructure will be used to achieve educational goals.

- 13. Memorandum of Agreement between the School Board and Health Department Black

This Memorandum of Agreement provides 13 nursing positions for 12 Alachua County public schools. It is a cooperative agreement, which reflects a state grant providing the funds for the Alachua County Health Department to hire school nurses.

- 14. Agreement between the School Board and Health Department..... Black

This agreement provides funding for employment of two registered nurses, one Clinic aide and one-half secretarial position in the Alachua County Public schools’ Health Services department. Total amount of reimbursement is \$104,743.

H. ACTION ITEMS

- 1. Administrative Appointment—Loften High School Principal..... Boyd

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board approve the appointment of Dr. Chet Sanders as principal of Loftan High School, effective June 7, 2006.

- 2. Reassignment of Students for the 2006-07 School Year—Second Reading Tougaw

A public hearing was held February 21, 2006, regarding the reassignment of students who reside in the Uptown Village, Walnut Creek and Eden Park developments.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board approve the reassignment of students for the 2006-2007 school year as presented.

- 3. Proclamation—April as “Jazz Appreciation Month” Shaw

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board adopt the Proclamation proclaiming the month of April as “Jazz Appreciation Month” in Alachua County schools.

- 4. Authorization to Proceed with Planning for a Half-Cent (0.5%) School Capital Outlay Surtax Boyd

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board authorize the administration to proceed with planning for a November 2006 referendum on a half-cent (0.5%) School Capital Outlay Surtax.

- 6. Change Order Number Three for Project SBAC E0432—Wiles Elementary School New Classroom Building Gable

This change order adds \$58,912.56 to the contract, revising the contract to \$1,823,451.39 and represents costs for removal and replacement of unsuitable soils. This change order adds forty-one (41) consecutive calendar days to the contract time.
