8. Credit Retrieval ..... Wise

This agreement is to purchase subscriptions to NOVEL™ online curriculum and textbooks in a credit retrieval program for the 2006-07 school year. This expenditure represents the third-year cost of the three-year contract approved by the School Board on August 3, 2004.

9. Design Development/Construction Documents for Project SBAC V0504—  
Santa Fe High School Equestrian Stables ..... Gable

Brame Architects, Gainesville, Florida, has prepared Design Development/Construction Documents for the construction of this project. It is requested that the Board approve these plans as presented.

10. Education for Homeless Children and Youth Grant Funds ..... Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education to request additional funds to continue the District's Education for Homeless Children and Youth grant. A total of \$67,000 is requested to employ a full-time social worker to coordinate provision of services for homeless students in all schools throughout the District. Funds will be used to purchase materials and supplies to enable students to participate in a full range of school activities.

11. 2005-2006 Succeed Florida—Career Paths ..... Omer

Two proposals have been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for career academies. A continuation grant of \$56,000 is requested for the Academy of Early Childhood Education at Newberry High School, and a new grant of \$75,000 is requested for adding Allied Health and EMT Training components to the Institute of Health Professions at Gainesville High School.

12. Title II, Part A—Preparing, Training and Recruiting Highly Qualified Teachers and Principals ..... Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for Title II, Part A grant funds. The Title II program is intended to increase student academic achievement through strategies such as improving teacher and principals' quality and increasing the number of highly qualified principals and assistant principals in schools.

- 13. Title V, Part A, Innovative Program Strategies ..... Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for Title V, Part A grant funds. The Title V program is to support local education reform and innovation.

- 14. Title III, English Language Acquisition ..... Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for a Title III, English Language Acquisition grant (formerly Emergency Immigrant Education Program). Funds will be used to pay for activities that provide enhanced instructional opportunities for immigrant children and youth. A total of \$57,11.02 is requested.

- 15. School Resource Officer—Gainesville Police Department ..... Omer

The Gainesville Police Department provides school resource officers in targeted elementary, middle and high schools.
