- 5. Multi-District Cooperative Agreement for Programs for Deaf/Hard of Hearing For Columbia, Gilchrist and Levy counties Black

This agreement provides for ESE services to students of these counties in the Deaf/Hard of Hearing Program within grade levels PK-5 at Lake Forest Elementary School. The cost of each county \$4,000 for each student.

- 6. Agreement with the Success for All Foundation, Inc. Black

This agreement will continue the Success for All program at the Anchor Center, Duval, Lake Forest and Shell Elementary schools. This agreement shall commence upon execution of this contract and continue until June 30, 2007.

- 7. Annual Agreement with Compass Learning, Inc. Black

This agreement provides for the annual software maintenance and support at Alachua County Training Center, Prairie View Academy, Anchor Center, Archer Community, Waldo Community, Alachua Elementary, Duval, Glen Springs, Idylwild, Irby, Lake Forest, Stephen Foster, Shell and Rawlings Elementary schools.

- 8. Approval of School Bus Routes for the 2006-2007 School Year Githens

The 2006-2007 School Bus Routes for all students is available for viewing on CICS or the SBAC website, under the Transportation Department.

- 9. Employee Case No. E-0405-11—Michael K. Scott Wittmer

The attorney for the employee has requested that the final hearing that was scheduled for August 10, 2006, be continued, and the employee be placed on a suspension without pay status. It is recommended that the employee be suspended without pay, effective August 7, 2006.

- 10. Adults with Disabilities Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Vocational Rehabilitation for continuation of funding for the district's Adults with Disabilities grant. A total of \$49,151 is requested to provide educational services for adults who have a medical verification of disability.

- 11. AmeriCorps—Alachua County Reads! Omer

This is the eighth year for district participation in the AmeriCorps Alachua County Reads! Program. This contract will fund a program manager, eight full-time and nine part-time AmeriCorps members to tutor targeted children in grades K-3.

- 12. Boys and Girls Club Mentoring Services Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for Boys and Girls Club Mentoring Services. The School Board of Alachua County will contract with the Boys and Girls Club of Alachua County to mentor at-risk students during after-school hours at four clubs—North West Center, South East Center, Woodland Park, and the Recihert House Unit. A total of \$51,301 is included in Florida Legislature's Specific Appropriation for Alachua County for this purpose.

- 13. Safe and Drug-Free Schools Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for a Safe and Drug-Free Schools Entitlement grant. Project funds will be used to support a half-time secretary, peer mediation and counselors, provides stipends for teachers to attend inservice training sessions, enable staff to travel to out-of-county to SDFS meetings, workshops and conferences, for student field trips, for consultants and to purchase curriculum materials and supplies.
