- 8. New Components for Master In-Service Plan..... Shewey

Several new components are recommended as additions to the Master In-Service Plan to meet staff needs.

- 9. Resolution No. 06-05—District Participation in the Crown Consortium..... Shewey

This Resolution adopts a plan for cooperating with the School Boards of other districts in an educational consortium, the Crown Consortium, for acquisition of materials, contracted services, and participation in programs, when such meets specific needs of the district and is deemed educationally/monetarily beneficial by the School Board.

- 10. Title I Supplemental Educational Services District/Provider Contracts..... Hall

Supplemental Educational Services (SES) Agreements have been prepared with various providers for the purpose of providing tutoring to eligible students as agreed upon in the Title I NCLB—Supplemental Educational Parent/District Provider Agreement. (Contracts available for review in Superintendent’s Office)

- 11. Agreement with the University of Florida Department of Pediatrics..... Black

This agreement will provide physical exams for students without insurance or funding to provide this service to students in need. The University of Florida Pediatrics Department also provides medical direction for the School Health Services Program, the School Health Advisory Council and the Communicable Disease Review Team.

12. Contract with ACORN Dental Clinic..... Crowell
- This agreement with ACORN Dental Clinic provides dental services to approximately 70 Head Start/School Readiness children during the 2006-07 school year. Services will include dental screening and appropriate follow-up sessions. Grant funds are provided specifically for this purpose.
13. Contract with the University of Florida Department of Pediatrics Crowell
- This agreement with the University of Florida College of Dentistry (Department of Pediatrics) provides dental services to approximately 400 Head Start/School Readiness children during the 2006-07 school year. Services will include dental screening and appropriate follow-up sessions. Grant funds are provided specifically for this purpose.
14. Design Development/Construction Documents for Project SBAC S0507—
Santa Fe High School Fire Alarm and Intercom Replacement Gable
- Brame Architects, Gainesville, Florida, has prepared Design Development/Construction Documents for the construction of this project. It is requested that the School Board approve these plans as presented.
15. Certificate of Final Inspection for Project SBAC A0433—Chiles Elementary
School New Classroom Building Gable
- This project has been inspected by the project architect and the facilities department staff. It is requested that the School Board authorize final payment to the contractor upon total acceptance of this project. Final contract amount is \$1,231,682.67.
16. Contract with DES of Florida, LLC..... Longstreth
- DES of Florida provides a means for administrators and professional/technical employees to retire when they complete DROP, but to be subcontracted to SBAC for a period of one year. The School Board previously signed an umbrella agreement with DES.
17. Head Start EDEP Fees..... Hollinger
18. Enhancing Education Through Technology I Grant..... Omer
- A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for an Enhancing Education Through Technology I grant. This is a formula grant that supports development and implementation of technology standards through district schools. It will provide teacher training in the standards. It is anticipated that a total of \$66,088.37 will be spent on this project.
19. Interlocal Agreement with the City of Gainesville for Implementing the 21st Century
Community Learning Centers Omer

The School Board is contracting \$247,165 to provide 21st Century Community Learning Centers activities at the Reichert House and the Teen Zone at the Eastside Park Community Center. Program activities are designed to improve students' academic performance, particularly in reading, and to provide engaging activities in a safe environment when school is not in session.

- 20. Safe and Drug-Free Schools (SDFS) Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for a Safe and Drug-Free Schools Entitlement grant. Project funds will be used to support a half-time secretary, peer mediation and counselors, stipends for teachers to attend in-service training sessions, staff travel to out-of-county SDFS meetings, workshops and conferences, student field trips, consultants and to purchase curriculum materials and supplies.
