A payment for services not to exceed \$149.32 per screening will be provided for each student.

- 13. Contractual Agreement with National Mentor Healthcare, Inc. Crowell

A contract has been prepared with National Mentor Healthcare, Inc., to provide Individual and group mental health/social emotional development consultation Services to preschool age children who are enrolled in the Head Start/School Readiness programs and have been identified, screened and referred for Professional services.
- 14. Lease of Parcel at Wiles Elementary School to Community Development Institute Head Start (CDI HS) Crowell

The lease will permit CDI HS to operate the Early Head Start Program from the seven (7) modular classrooms located on the northwest corner of the Wiles Elementary School campus.

4. School Planning Advisory Committee (SPAC) Gable

In accordance with Section 4 of the existing Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning, adopted by the Board in November 2003, the School Board will establish a School Planning Advisory Committee (SPAC) for the purpose of reviewing and making recommendations to the Superintendent regarding potential sites for new schools, proposals for significant school expansions, and potential closures of existing schools.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board approve the assignments to the SPAC Committee, including community members and staff representatives from the local governments as outlined in the Interlocal Agreement as presented.

5. Constitutional Challenge to Florida Schools of Excellence Commission Boyd

House Bill 135 was enacted and created the Florida Schools of Excellence (FSE) Commission, which is an independent, state-level charter school authorizing entity, with members being appointed by the State Board of Education. The creation of the FSE Commission raises several constitutional questions relating to the power of elected school boards throughout the State of Florida to approve the establishment of and regulation of charter schools within a school district.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board apply for exemption from the Florida Schools of Excellence Commission.
