This agreement with Santa Fe Community College, acting for and on behalf of the Florida Dance Association, provides transportation for the Florida Dance Festival Tour 2006 on Saturday, October 28, 2006.

- 8. Project Priority List Gable

The Project Priority List (PPL) is required for projects funded from Capital Outlay and Debt Service (CO & DS) funds, and State Board of Education (SBE). The Superintendent requests that the School Board approve the PPL for submission to the Florida Department of Education.

- 9. Professional Services Ranking for Project SBAC W0601—Districtwide Energy Conservation Project Gable

Interviews were conducted on September 20, 2006, for the design professional on this project. It is requested that the School Board accept the following ranking: 1) BCA, Inc., Maitland, Florida; 2) Ameresco, Inc., Tampa, Florida; 3) BGA, Inc., Tampa, Florida.

- 10. Boys and Girls Club of Alachua County Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for Boys and Girls Club Mentoring Services. The School Board of Alachua County will contract with the Boys and Girls Club of Alachua County to mentor at-risk students during after-school hours at four (4) clubs—North West Center, South East Center, Woodland Park, and Reichert House Unit. A total of \$51,301 is included in the Florida Legislature’s Specific Appropriation for Alachua County for this purpose.

- 11. Subcontract with University of Florida Omer

The University of Florida’s National Science Foundation grant has been extended. An agreement has been prepared with the University of Florida to conduct activities related to an education project entitled “Science partners in Inquiry-based Collaborative Education” (SPICE). Under the terms of the agreement, funds in the amount of \$47,054 will be provided to the school system to employ a Teacher Specialist to coordinate program activities.

- 12. Contract with DES of Florida, LLC (Dr. Charles Hall) Longstreth

DES of Florida provides a means for administrators and professional/technical employees to retire when they complete DROP, but to be subcontracted to SBAC for a period of one year. The SBAC previously signed an umbrella agreement with DES. The Superintendent recommends the return of Dr. Charles Hall to his position for a period of one year upon his retirement from SBAC on 9/30/06.

- 13. Agreement with University of Florida Department of Psychiatry Black

This agreement with the University of Florida Department of Psychiatry provides mental health consultations, diagnosis and suggested treatment for Alachua County Public School students in need of mental health services who do not have either health insurance or funding to receive such services. Students who display disruptive behavior in school, are at-risk for failure without mental health services.

- 14. Agreement with Dr. Janet Greene, Ed.S. Black

This agreement with Dr. Janet Greene provides mental health counseling, group counseling, risk assessment and consultation with parents and staff. Students who display disruptive behavior in school, are at risk for failure without mental health services.

- 15. Agreement with the University of Florida Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders Black

This agreement with the University of Florida Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders provides language and literacy stimulation programs to “at-risk” children at Rawlings Elementary School. The program will be funded by the Scottish Rite Foundation of Florida.

- 16. Memorandum of Understanding with NEFEC..... Wise

This Memorandum of Understanding provides for Northeast Florida Educational Consortium (NEFEC) reimbursement to the School Board of funds related to the district’s Credit Retrieval Program (CROP).
