APPROVED CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS

- (1) Change Order Number Eight for Project SBAC C0032 – Shell Elementary School New Multi-Purpose Building

On September 25, 2006, the Superintendent authorized execution of Change Order Number Eight to the construction contract. This change orders adds \$8,310.72, to the contract, revising the contract total to \$1,935,672.02, and represents costs for unused balances on direct purchase of materials and supplies. This change order adds no calendar days to the contract time. This is the final change order on this project.
