Supplemental Educational Services (SES) Agreements have been prepared for Childstart Learning Solutions and Carter Reddy & Associates, Inc., for the purpose of providing tutoring to eligible students as agreed upon in the Title I NCLB-Supplemental Educational Parent/District Provider Agreement.

- 10. Agreement with the University of Florida for Audiology Services Black

This agreement with the University of Florida, Department of Communicative Disorders, provides for audiology services for students attending Alachua County schools in grades designated in the School Board's 2006-07 School Health Services Plan, all new elementary students, and those "at risk" in all other grades. Services include: hearing screenings, evaluation and diagnostic assessments for selected students, and training of volunteers. The agreement is effective August 15, 2006, through May 31, 2007, with an annual cost of \$32,500 (payable in four payments during the year.)

- 11. School Improvement Guide for 2006-2007 Anusavice

Each year the Curriculum Division puts together the School Improvement Guide to assist schools in developing their School Improvement Plans. It is also designed to provide School Advisory Councils with technical assistance and guidance.
