- 9. Contract with Santa Fe Community College for Child Development Training Crowell

A contract has been prepared with Santa Fe Community College to provide child development training for the Head Start program. The contract covers an application fee, tuition, textbooks, and educational supplies. Contract not to exceed \$40,000.

- 10. Contract with T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood Scholarship Program..... Crowell

A contract has been prepared with T.E.A.C.H. (Teacher Education and Compensation Helps) Early Childhood Scholarship Program to provide scholarships for Head Start staff to work toward earning an AS degree in Child Development and Education, or a Child Development Associate Credential. The contract establishes a partnership for the sharing of expenses by the scholarship recipient, the Head Start program, and the T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood Scholarship Program.

- 11. A Business-Community (ABC) School Program..... Hollinger

A new law passed by the 2006 Florida Legislature, Section 1013.721, requires school districts to solicit applications from local businesses that may be interested in providing space for a K-3 classroom at their worksite for the children of employees. The law is referred to as 'A Business-Community (ABC) School Program.

- 12. Alachua County School Resource Officer Program..... Omer

An agreement has been prepared for submission to the Alachua County Sheriff's Office (ASO) for the continuation of the School Resource Officer Program. This is an agreement whereby ASO will provide 16 School Resource Deputies to local schools and centers between October 1, 2006, and September 30, 2007. Up to \$417,657 will be paid by the Alachua County Public Schools to ASO for these deputies to provide public safety and prevention and intervention education programs at the schools. An additional \$6,000 for instructional materials and School Resource Deputy training may be paid, provided materials and training are approved by the District Security Chief.

- 13. Certificate of Final Inspection for Project SBAC A0503—High Springs Community School Restroom Renovations Gable

This project has been inspected by the project architect and the facilities department staff. It is requested that the School Board authorize final payment to the contractor upon total acceptance of this project. Final contract amount is \$109,079.61.

- 14. Proposal to Continue Agreement with P. K. Yonge School Eunice

Based on a successful pilot initiated two years ago, it is recommended that the School Board of Alachua County renew an agreement with P. K. Yonge School to operate the School Food and Nutrition Service Breakfast and Lunch Program for the 2006-2009 school years. It is mutually agreed that the program has performed well, not only financially, but based on overall acceptance by the P. K. Yonge staff and students.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board accept the low base bid of \$743,469 and additive alternates 1, 2, and 3 in the amount of \$76,469 and award a contract for construction totaling \$819,938 to Bonner Roofing and Sheet Metal Company, Sanford, Florida. Completion of the project shall be within one hundred twenty (120) consecutive calendar days.

- 4. Bid Award for Project SBAC R0503—Lincoln Middle School Roof Replacement..... Gable

Bids for the construction of this project were received on November 14, 2006.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board accept the low base bid of \$1,234,469 and award a contract for construction to Bonner Roofing and Sheet Metal Company, Sanford, Florida. Completion of the project shall be within one hundred eighty (180) consecutive calendar days.

APPROVED CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER(S)

- (1) Change Order Number One for Project SBAC A0503 – High Springs Community School Restroom Renovations

On November 6, 2006, the Superintendent authorized execution of Change Order Number One. This change order adds \$11,693.61 to the contract and represents additional costs for the replacement of existing plumbing pipes and toilet fittings, and for the installation of owner furnished door frames, doors and hardware. This change order adds fourteen (14) consecutive calendar days to the contract time. This is the final change order for this project.

D. DISTRICT-WIDE DATA COMMUNICATION
AND TRANSPORT SERVICES

(RFP #07-14)
Information Resources
(General Fund)

The bid establishes fixed monthly rates for circuit-by-circuit data communication and transport services (network services) from/to all SBAC schools and centers to/from the Information Resources' Central Data Center. The successful vendors will supply all labor, materials, equipment, and software necessary to provide network connections to 47 District schools and support facilities. The contract is effective December 5, 2006, and the successful vendors will begin supplying network services on July 1, 2007. The contract ends December 4, 2011. The cost of this service is eligible for reimbursement under the E-Rate discount program.
