Mr. Eubank presented a request for information, based on his budget concerns about grant funding, use of Title I funding, and technology spending without appropriate planning. He expressed overall concern for the District's financial future.

Mrs. Sharpe reported on an FSBA Conference presentation that highlighted technology use as an 'equalizer' among students, with accountability showing rising performance.

Mrs. Childs spoke in support of even greater technology goals and clear communication with employees hired through grant funding.

Mrs. Roy concurred with the matter of communication concerning grant-funded positions. She also had brief questions on the technology program and funding for reading coaches.

Deputy Superintendent Sandy Hollinger stated that she will respond to Mr. Eubank's request by memo to all Board members.
