40-Book Challenge 1st Benchmark

The Hidden Oak Book Challenge is under way! This school-wide program challenges every student (brick and mortar and digital acade-my) K–5 to read 40 books by the end of the school year. Students in 3–5 are also chal-lenged to read books in seven different gen-res each month. October's genre is nonfiction.

In addition, 3–5 grade students who read a 200-page book can count that as two books, and a 300-page book as three books! Make sure your student is filling out the reading log to keep track of how many books they are reading. Our first benchmark is Friday, October 23.
