# 10 Tips for Parents about Social Media/Internet Safety

- 1. Educate yourself about the different platforms/apps (Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, Snapchat, WhatsApp, Tumblr, Reddit, Xbox Live, PlayStation Plus, Twitter, HouseParty, Discord, and more!).
- 2. Establish an age limit for different programs.
- 3. Regularly check your child's privacy settings.
- 4. Keep your child's profile private.
- 5. Ensure they are not posting personal details (phone numbers, address, last name, birthday, etc.).
- 6. Don't allow them to post videos or photos that jeopardize their safety or character.
- 7. Make sure they choose a strong password and *that* you know their passwords.
- 8. Never allow them to accept friend requests/follows from people they do not know.
- 9. Set guidelines and rules for social media use and be sure to enforce the rules.
- 10. Be sure to keep an open dialogue with your children.
