Inform parent that student needs to self- isolate for 14 days and be symptom free before returning to school. Close off areas requiring disinfecting until cleaning protocols have been followed. Assure the areas are cleaned and disinfected. Assign a designee to document the date student is allowed to return and ensure attendance clerk verifies the student is not on campus for the allotted days.*
