- Email Ms. Harris (harrisall@gm.sbac.edu) a picture of your family project for us to share on the morning announcements or in future newsletters.

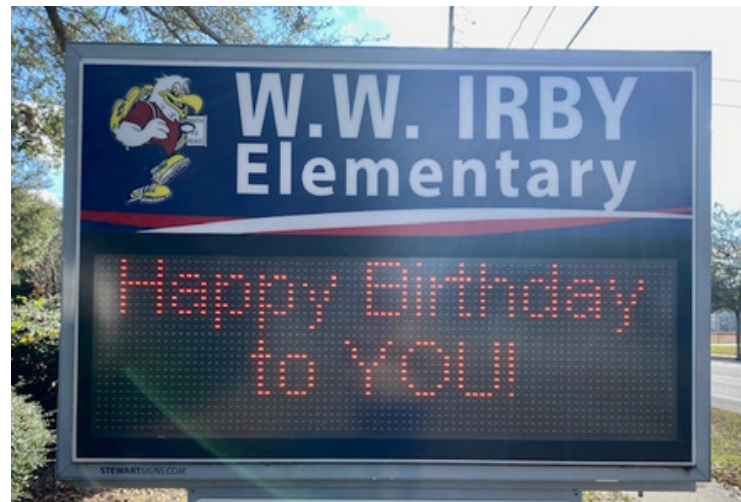

Welcome to Music, Everyone!

Our Irby Eagle musicians have been playing and working hard in the music room. 2nd grade started an introductory ukulele unit this Spring, learning to play open strings and strum while singing. They continue their part work by playing ostinatos on Orff instruments (xylophones) and playing accompaniments to songs. They are currently learning the basics of harmony by singing rounds.



First Grade has been practicing music notation by reading quarter notes and eighth notes. They are also reading, playing, and composing 2 note solfege melodies (think do re mi! 😊) with the notes sol and mi. They will soon be introduced to more notes of the scale and quarter rest. In addition to all these concepts, first and second grades have been preparing for their Spring programs!

Kindergarten kicked off the Spring concert season with their “Baby Beluga” musical. They had an **OUTSTANDING** performance and I am so very proud of their hard work. First grade will have their own show on Tuesday, April 11th at 6:30pm. They will be showcasing some of the wonderful multicultural music they have learned this year. Second grade’s performance will be on Thursday, May 18th at 6:30pm. They will be sharing the music they have learned on Orff instruments, ukuleles, drums, and other percussion.
