**PLCP** is Alachua County's alternate path to satisfy the professional preparation requirements for a Professional Educator's Certificate. See [here](#) for other options available as well. **Updated 05/20/24**

It is a requirement to have a mentor while you move through the PLCP program. Ask your principal to make a recommendation for someone on your campus who could be a mentor to you. PLCP mentors MUST:

- Be RECOMMENDED by the principal and the admin has verified that the mentor has:
  - rated effective or highly effective on their annual performance appraisal **and**
  - completed Clinical Educator training **and**
  - **3+** years of teaching experience
- attend PLCP orientation with participating teacher

*Please work on securing a mentor prior to the orientation as he/she will need to attend with you! You will want to share the zoom meeting information below with your mentor to attend.*
