1. Free of pornography and material prohibited under s. 847.012.
2. Suited to student needs and their ability to comprehend the material presented.
3. Appropriate for the grade level and age group for which the materials are used or made available.

In addition, consultation of reputable, professionally recognized reviewing periodicals and school community stakeholders is included in every purchase.

Plan for Growth

Based on the demographic information, student achievement scores and current collection analysis, selection priorities have been established.

Year 1: (2024-2025)

- Weed books in all areas of the library that have not been checked out for five years.
- Continue to add engaging picture books, fiction books, and biographies to the collection. Continue to add new additions to popular series in the easy, biography, graphic novel and fiction sections.

Year 2: (2025 - 2026)

- Replace older books in the 500 section. Find interesting books that are appropriate reading levels on the topics of earth sciences, geology, plants, and animals.
- Continue to update the 300 section by adding new books about customs, holidays, fairy tales, folktale, and fables. Continue to add new additions to popular series in the easy, biography, graphic novel and fiction sections.

Year 3: (2026-2027)

- Review items that have not been checked out for the last five years.
- Update and add to the 700 section. Consider sports titles and new drawing books. Add books to the 900 section. Find new books on history and geography. Continue to add books to the 400 section that represent languages spoken by students at our school. Continue to add new additions to popular series in the easy, biography, graphic novel and fiction sections.
