Session Specifics

Reading/ELA

Students will review/practice reading comprehension strategies designed to improve performance on the FSA ELA Reading Test. Concepts to be covered include main idea and details, sequencing, compare and contrast, fact and opinion, cause and effect, making inferences, identifying and analyzing text evidence

Science

Students will take part in assessment reviews, labs, and hands-on activities to support 6th, 7th, and 8th grade concepts as well as preparation for the FSA Science assessment. Concepts to be covered include scientific method, variables, and constructing labs, as well as other important topics we've covered in middle school. The science review will be set up in 25 minute stations where students will focus on different topics at each station by partaking in interactive and learning activities.

Algebra I

Algebra I and Algebra I Honors is a high school math course exploring how to use variables and numbers with mathematical symbols to solve problems. Review Sessions will highlight evaluating expressions, writing and solving equations, graphing functions, solving quadratics, square roots, exponential functions, understanding inequalities, and reviewing Statistics. Vocabulary, concepts, and study tips will be provided to help prepare your student for success on the EOC assessment.
