Earning the AICE Diploma

The Cambridge AICE Diploma requires students to accumulate 7 credits from a combination of the compulsory core subject, Cambridge AS Level Global Perspectives & Research, and the three curriculum areas: mathematics and science (Group 1), languages (Group 2), and arts and humanities (Group 3). There is the option to study interdisciplinary subjects (Group 4).

To earn the AICE Cambridge Diploma, you must accumulate each credit through participation in a designated AICE class and passing the associated exam. Credits may be earned by sitting for up to three exam series within a 25- month period. Exams are offered in the spring/summer (April-June) of each year. This means that the 7 credits must be completed by the end of the 12th grade year. The chart below represents courses currently offered by Gainesville High School. Please circle the courses you have completed and have either taken or are registered to take the exam.
