

While writing notes, try to group ideas and events into common themes. For example, John Cabot explored North America on behalf of England and Ferdinand Magellan went to the Philippines and declared that they were part of Spain. Both of these people and events could be grouped together as examples of empire-building.

Another example could be the Atlantic Slave trade and the proliferation of factories. At first glance, one might wonder what these two things have in common. However, what inspired and resulted from both of these practices was an emphasis on business and making money. Other examples to look for in the reading are religions, social changes (like the role of women in different places), political revolutions, wars and battles, and technology (for example, the creation of gunpowder and advanced irrigation methods).
