

HOMECOMING COURT CONTRACT

Criteria for selecting a homecoming court at Hawthorne MH School can help ensure that the process is fair, inclusive, and reflects the school community's values. Below are the criteria to be eligible to run for homecoming court:

Eligibility Criteria

1. Grade Level: Candidates must be in a specific grade (e.g., juniors and seniors) to be eligible.
2. Academic Standing: Candidates should maintain a minimum GPA (e.g., **2.0 or higher**) to qualify.
3. Behavioral Record: Candidates should have a clean disciplinary record, free from major infractions such as **suspensions** or **TWO (2) referrals** beginning September 10, 2024 - October 4, 2024.

Nomination Process

Self-Nomination: Students may nominate themselves if they meet the eligibility criteria.

Voting Process

1. Grade Level Prince and Princesses: Students will vote **ONLY** for their current grade level
2. Homecoming King and Queen: All students may vote for homecoming king and queen

Final Selection

1. Votes will be counted by **THREE (3)** adults.
2. If there's a tie, a revote will occur between the persons tied.

Disqualification

Violation of Criteria: If any court member fails to maintain the eligibility criteria after selection, they may be disqualified and replaced.
