The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring tool that will be administered three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year.

Your student has completed participating in the first (PM1) FAST assessments in Reading and Math. Your student's results from PM1 are for informational purposes only.

You can access your student's scores through Skyward Family Access.

- Once in Skyward Family Access, click District Links in the top right corner.
- Choose FAST Progress Monitoring.
- Scores and a graph for the test your student has taken this year will be displayed.
