Dear Parents,

Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year at J.J. Finley! We are very excited about the new year with our new school wide theme, "Learning is my Super Power". Procedures for Student Drop-Off

To ensure the safety of our students, we implemented the following drop-off procedure. Our Safety Patrols and several faculty members will be available to assist students and parents. If you wish to walk your child into the building, please park your car along 7th Avenue or 19th Street and walk your child to the building. Thank you for following these procedures:

- Students should exit the car from the passenger/curb side

Pupil Progression Plan

The Florida School Code requires that promotion of students be based on proficiency in reading, writing, math, and science. Students who do not meet specific levels of performance may be retained.

The Florida School Code also requires mandatory retention of third grade students who are deficient in reading (Level I on FSA reading). Students who are at risk of scoring Level I on the new Florida Standards Assessment will receive additional diagnostic assessment and intensive instruction in reading.

Third grade parents will receive a district letter regarding the mandatory retention policy for third grade students who are deficient in reading.

Welcome back and welcome to third grade! This year our superhero power is learning!

The third-grade team extends a superpower welcome to our newest team members, Ms. Hodge and Mrs. Kelly. Mrs. Stevens will also be joining 3rd grade as our title I reading teacher. We are excited to have such an experienced group of teachers on the third-grade team!

There are many new learning opportunities ahead for this year. In third grade students earn letter grades on every report card. Another important milestone in third grade is the transition from learning to read, to reading to learn.

There are two projects all third graders get the opportunity to complete. One is the shoebox adventure book project. Students each read a book and create a shoebox "float." The floats are strolled around campus, parade style, with lots of cheers and encouragement from other grade levels. Families are invited. This year is our 21st annual Shoebox Float Parade. Wow!

The second project is called the Wax Museum. Students each read a biography book. During the Wax Museum, students dress in character and recite a memorized speech like a statue coming alive.

Third grade field trips offer lots of fun and learning. Throughout the year third graders will journey to the UF Fisheries, The Thomas Center, and the Santa Fe Zoo and Planetarium.

Academically, Social Studies will be integrated with our reading curriculum this year and we will continue to encourage our students to be lifelong readers. In math students will practice addition and subtraction facts to gain fluency and by the end of the year third graders will be well on their way to being fluent in multiplication facts up to twelve. Fourth graders can look forward to our trip to the Florida Museum of Natural History in December and the traditional field trip to St. Augustine in March. Our spring musical will be "Lewis and Clark"... I mean "Clark and Lewis" and you can look forward to enjoying that after spring break.



Fifth Grade

Welcome to 5th grade at J.J. Finley! The fifth-grade year is a very special year for students. It will be a year filled with experiences and opportunities that will create lasting memories for your child.

Fifth graders will be traveling to Camp Crystal Lake for three days and two nights from February 14th-16th. This special trip allows our fifth graders to experience life at camp. They will eat family style meals and sleep in cabins. At camp, we will study important science curriculum in an outdoor setting. Students will roast marshmallows, hike, and participate in team building activities. We will need many parent chaperones for this trip. We hope you will consider coming to camp for all, or part, of the trip with your fifth grader.

In addition to attending great field trips, such as Camp Crystal, fifth graders also have the opportunity to be a part of the Safety Patrol program. This special privilege is exclusively for students who demonstrate citizenship and set a positive example for other students by maintaining good grades and behavior. More information on the application process will go home throughout the year.

Building responsibility is an important aspect of the fifth-grade year. Please help us by checking and signing the student planner daily. Setting aside time for homework each night and making sure your child has a quiet place to read for thirty minutes every day will help promote your child's academic success.

Multiplication facts are the foundation for the math that we will learn this year. Please practice facts at home to help your student commit them to memory. We will spend a considerable amount of time on division and fraction concepts in math. Multiplication fluency is essential for mastery of these math concepts.

There are three units of study in the science curriculum. We will study Physical Science, Earth Science, and Life Science. In fifth grade, all students learn about the engineering design process through a robotics program. Students will work in teams to build and then modify a robot for the competition.

Our Social Studies curriculum is based on the McGraw Hill Florida Social Studies program. This year, social studies will be taught by the language arts teacher and integrated within the reading curriculum.

Our reading curriculum is wonderful! The main reading selections are based on social studies or science topics. Students will learn new vocabulary, reading skills, spelling, and grammar for each week. There will be four quarterly tests to assess student progress throughout the year. Students will be expected to read passages and use the information they learned to construct a response that answers multiple questions presented in the prompt. Students will learn how to support their answers with evidence from the text.

The fifth-grade team encourages you to communicate often with your child's teacher. We will send a monthly newsletter for fifth grade called the Fifth-Grade Flyer.

It is great to be back at Finley! I hope you all had a relaxing summer. For families who are new to our school, the School Counseling Office at J.J. Finley is located in the front office. My name is Kathy Grantham and I am the School Counselor at Finley; Ms. Kim Miller is our guidance/ESE secretary. The School Counseling office coordinates paperwork & testing for special programs, & schedules EPT (Educational Planning Team) meetings and staffings for teachers and parents.

This year at Finley, we will be using "superpowers" to be awesome learners! Look for info on the following upcoming events during this school year:

- Character Traits
- Good attendance
- Healthy habits
- Learning and study strategies
- Good decision-making skills
- Problem solving skills
- Career interests
- Hope for The Holidays program

As the school counselor, I work with all students in classroom guidance lessons, but also with students individually and in small groups. Classroom guidance lessons will begin during the first month of school. I complete 1-3 units in each grade level per year. The units build upon one another from year to year. Guidance units are usually 4-6 lessons in each class. The lessons are approximately 30 minutes each. My lessons use research based strategies that have produced strong results in student performance and improvement in skills. The activities may include literature, discussion, role play, puppets, music, problem solving, art and games. Ultimately our goal is to teach the students to "think it through" – no matter what the situation may be:

- Studying for a test
- Being a friend
- Responding to a negative comment
- Saying no to harmful habits
- Managing time.

The topics of goals & careers will be infused into much of our classroom guidance lessons. Statistics show that children who have a vision for themselves and their future, and know more about their personal strengths (and weaknesses) are more adept at setting realistic goals for themselves. Kids who have goals are more likely to stay in school, and be successful. Prior to classroom guidance lessons, parents will receive a letter giving more information and details about the unit of study and our lesson activities.

Welcome back Finley Flyer Musicians!! I & Joanna Barousse, our new itinerant music teacher, are excited to begin a new school year with everyone in music classes. Every JJ Finley student benefits from the program. Some of the funds allocated in previous years have been used to purchase Smart Board systems, document cameras and classroom computers. Title 1 funds are also used for academic support in instructional strategies based on scientifically based research. The district has chosen to implement a different model at all the Title 1 schools this year. This year we will be reducing reading classes in 2nd and 3rd grade. Additionally, our teachers will benefit from additional support through the use of an instructional coach.

Many resources are provided throughout the school year for students and their families. There is a parent resource section of the media center with books, articles and videos available for checkout.

We encourage all parents to be involved in school activities. A School-Parent Compact goes home at the beginning of the year to all families. Please take time to read and discuss the compact with your student. During the school year, teachers will be referring to the compact as it is an agreement between the school, parents, and students about academic responsibilities and expectations. There will also be parent workshops offered during the school year -- please look for those flyers as they come home.
