



Covid-19 Vaccination Opportunity!

Attention Parents/Guardians:

The Alachua County School Board has partnered with the Alachua County Health Department to provide Covid vaccinations to Alachua County School system students. Vaccination is the safest most effective way to help prevent the spread of the Corona virus among your family and your community.

*All students 16 years of age and older will be offered the Pfizer vaccine at NO COST TO THEIR FAMILIES!

Take advantage of this program by:

- **Reading** the Fact Sheet for Recipients and Caregivers and the Notice of Privacy

AND

- **Filling out** the consent form, attached, and returning it to your child's school, fax to (352) 334-7947, or EMAIL it to; SLIV@flhealth.gov, before April 22, 2021.

(Please note that e-mailing may not be a secure method of communication)

Home schooled and Virtual learning children may also receive the Pfizer vaccine at the school on the scheduled date.

Your school will let you know when your child will be receiving the Covid Vaccine, should you sign them up.

Staff will review your child's form to determine if s/he can receive the Pfizer Covid 19 vaccine. You will be contacted if your child is ineligible for vaccination. If your child cannot receive the vaccine at the school, we strongly recommend you arrange with your child's primary care provider as soon as possible.
