

ATTENTION PARENTS: it's not too late to help your child become a better reader before the new school year begins. Summer is an important time for students to keep reading and improve their language skills. If your child hasn't been reading regularly this summer, they may be in danger of the "summer slide"—a decline in their reading ability.

Numerous studies indicate that students who don't read or read infrequently during their summer vacation see their reading abilities stagnate or decline. This effect becomes more pronounced as students get older and advance through the school system.

"It's like if you play an instrument but put it down for three months," said Laurie Calvert, a teacher who is working as the Director of Teacher Outreach at ED. She wrote an academic thesis on improving summer reading programs at her North Carolina high school. "You're not going to be as good as a person who continues to play the instrument over those three months."

This "summer slide" can be avoided by ensuring that children are as engaged as possible in whatever they choose to read—just as long as they're reading every day.

"Anything that keeps students reading works," Calvert said. "The more engaged you are in the text, the closer you're going to read it. The closer you read it, the more you comprehend. And that process grows your skill."

- 1. Each guestion must have 4 possible choices.

Character Alphabet! – using notebook paper or Google Docs/MS Word

Choose a character you liked from the series and then create sentences using a main word that begins with the next letter in the alphabet – your goal is to show your deep knowledge of the character. You will end up with a sentence for each letter of the alphabet (X and Z will work as long as your main word in the sentence contains that letter)

For example, if your favorite character was the Giant from the tale of "Jack and the Beanstalk", your Character Alphabet might look like this:

A is for the ANGER the giant felt when he realized Jack had stolen his harp and hen.

B is for the BREAD that the giant wanted to make using Jack's bones.

C is for the CHOPPING of the vine that caused the giant to fall to his death.

... and so on until you get to Z! (And remember, most characters have something $E\underline{X}TRA$ or $CRA\underline{Z}Y$ going on at some point in their story....)

Infographic! – using posterboard-sized paper or an online app/site (just Google search the phrase "infographic creator", there are several very good free sites that can be used) or Google Slides/MS PowerPoint

- 1. Make sure the title of the series is strongly featured.
- 2. Use words, phrases, and sentences that illustrate or tell about important
 - (A) Settings, (B) Characters, and (C) Events in the series.
- 3. Use images (drawn or collected from the internet, magazines, etc.) to help illustrate what you are describing in #2.
- 4. Work to create at least 12 such words, phrases, or sentences for #2 so that the whole posterboard paper or computer graphic will be covered.
- 5. The viewer of your Infographic should be able to get a good feel for the main characters, places, and events in the series.

Cartoon It! (aka "Storyboard It!") – using paper or MS PowerPoint/Google Slides

Think of the plot for the series and create at least one panel (8.5"x11" piece of paper, PPT slide, etc.) to illustrate *each* of those important moments. You should use both images (drawn or collected from the internet, magazines, etc.) as well as words (both descriptions as well as "speech bubbles").

Remember plot structure?

Exposition (Introduces the Setting [where and when] and Main Characters [protagonist, antagonist])

Conflict (What is the problem that the protagonist(s) are faced with having to overcome?)

Rising Action (What events lead up to the "big moment" in the story?) – this will require several pieces of paper or slides because in a series there are a <u>lot</u> of different events that lead up to that ultimate "big moment".

Climax (The "big moment" in the story, where the main problem is either solved or it isn't.)

Falling Action (What events happen as a direct result of the Climax?)

Resolution (How is the story ended, how have the main characters changed, what are they doing?)


Finishing School series by Gail Carriger

Matt Cruse series by Kenneth Oppel


3 Books (Book 1: Airborn)


Stargirl series by Jerry Spinelli

Seeds of America series by Laurie Halse Anderson


3 Books (Book 1: Chains)

4 Books (Book 1: Al Capone Does My Shirts)


All Moose wants to do is protect his sister, live up to his parents' expectations, and stay out of trouble. But on Alcatraz, trouble is never very far away.


Randoms series by David Liss

He's seen Steelheart bleed. And he wants revenge.






Mr. Lemonchello's Library series by Chris Grabenstein

Silver Jaguar series by Kate Messner


3 Books (Book 1: Capture the Flag)

Bad Girls Don't Die series by Katie Alender


3 Books (Book 1: Bad Girls Don't Die)



Based on the bestselling horror video game series, Five Nights at Freddy's follows a young woman named Charlotte, who reunites with her childhood friends on the anniversary of the tragedy that ripped their town apart. It's been exactly ten years since the murders at Freddy Fazbear's Pizza, and Charlotte, who goes by the name Charlie, has spent the last ten years trying to forget. Friends and foes. Danger and magic. Death and life.


Most kids would do anything to pass the Iron Trial.

Three siblings, impatiently awaiting the return of their long lost parents. Together they will learn:


- 1. Magic is real.


Savvy series by Ingrid Law

Cole Matthews is angry. Angry, defiant, smug--in short, a bully. His anger has taken him too far this time, though. After beating up a ninth-grade classmate to the point of brain damage, Cole is facing a prison sentence.

But then a Tlingit Indian parole officer named Garvey enters his life, offering an alternative called Circle Justice, based on Native American traditions, in which victim, offender, and community all work together to find a healing solution. Privately, Cole sneers at the concept, but he's no fool--if it gets him out of prison, he'll do anything.

Ultimately, Cole ends up banished for one year to a remote Alaskan island, where his arrogance sets him directly in the path of a mysterious, legendary white bear. Mauled almost to death, Cole awaits his fate and begins the transition from anger to humility.

4 Books (Book 1: Cryptid Hunters)

Can a mythical bear help a boy beyond human reach?

Whatever you do to the animals, you do to yourself. Remember that.

After their parents are lost in an accident, thirteenyear old twins Grace and Marty are whisked away to live with their Uncle Wolfe – an uncle that they didn't even know they had! The intimidating Uncle Wolfe is an anthropologist who has dedicated his life to finding cryptids, mysterious creatures believed to be long extinct.

Just as the twins and their uncle are getting to know one another, Wolfe finds out that his nemesis, Dr. Blackwood, is headed to a Congolese jungle to poach a dinosaur and her clutch. Wolfe has to mobilize his team immediately if he wants to beat Blackwood to the jungle. And his team does not include the twins.

But Grace and Marty aren't easily left behind.
