Please pay special attention to the details regarding the Senior Trip to Busch Gardens on Wednesday, June 9.

- All trip participants **must be present in the bus loop by 7:45am**. You must park in your usual parking places. There is no parking in the rear of the school. All Senior trip participants **must be cleared from the debt list**.
- You must bring your permission slip, signed by a parent with all contact information completed and turn in to Mrs. Roberts or Mrs. Rye no later than Friday, June 2. You may not board the bus without Mrs. Roberts having a completed permission slip signed <u>by a parent, regardless of your age</u>.
- You are **not permitted** to bring any food or drink on the bus.
- Dress code, bags, and pockets will be checked prior to boarding the bus, as well as prior to entering the park. **Dress Code is the SBAC policy.** Failure to follow the dress code will prevent you from attending the trip.
- You will be going through a **security check** upon entry. Anything deemed inappropriate will be confiscated and not returned. Any illegal substances or items will be dealt with by the appropriate authorities.
- All bags, backpacks and packages are subject to inspection prior to entering the park.
- All persons are subject to screening for prohibited items using walk-through or hand-held metal detectors prior to entering the park.
- Any item that a guest presents that security deems unsafe or inappropriate will also not be inside the park. These decisions are made on a case by case basis.
- Please leave any unnecessary articles secured within your vehicle to expedite your entry into the park.
- You will receive a **wristband** that must be worn at all times until attendance has been taken for the return home. The wristband will allow you all-day dining. This band gives you one entrée per hour and unlimited drinks at the locations designated on your park map all day.
- You will need to have your own money to purchase any other food and/or souvenirs.
- Keep all receipts for anything that you purchase while in the parks as proof of purchase.
- Please report to the Dragon Fire Pub and Grill for any student issues that require the attention of a chaperone. There will be a chaperone stationed there to help you.
- We will board the buses promptly at 9:00pm. Plan ahead to be prompt in your return!
- We will **return home at around 11:00pm**. Please be prepared to **immediately** leave campus upon our return. **IF YOU ARE BEING PICKED UP, MAKE SURE YOUR RIDE IS THERE WHEN WE ARRIVE**!!!!!!!!!!
