Eating Breakfast or Lunch with your child

All visitors on campus must be screened and documented through the district system. This does require a valid photo I.D. We will happily host lunch visitors on each day **except Wednesdays.**

Morning Drop off and Afternoon Dismissal

If you are a returning Steamer Family, you know that our morning drop off and dismissal lines can be long at the beginning. Enhancements to our system are being made to elevate our student safety protocols each day.

Morning Drop Off

- Please pull to the front of the line, do not stop at the first gate.
- Do not stop at the cones to drop off or within the parking lot. Drive to the gates where adults are present to assist your child.

Parent Walk up

We will no longer use the gate at the far end of the parking lot for walk up drop off or pick up. *If you are escorting your student, you will need to walk them to the gate at the main office.* This will also be their pick up location, no longer at the carline area.

No students will be called out to the car line gates for walk ups.

Afternoon Dismissal

We call students from the classrooms as you pull into the parking lot.

To expedite this process:

• Please have your Car Pick up card displayed with your student's name written in bold letters and their grade or teacher's name.

Dismissal Changes: Please submit to Mrs. Settles in the main office before 1p.m.
