Hello, Parents and Guardians!

As the first quarter of school comes to an end, students in grades 3-5 will be taking quarterly assessments to monitor their progress thus far. During the week of October 10-15<sup>th</sup>, they will be taking the AIMS assessment in the area of Science. AIMS is an assessment that students in the district take at the end of every 9 weeks of school to determine which skills and concepts they have mastered during that quarter. Teachers will be able to share your child's results with you during parent/teacher conferences.

Additionally, by the end of the first week of this month, you should receive F.A.S.T. reports for Reading and Math, and DIBELS reports. These reports will indicate your child's academic level in the tested areas. These test results are baseline results, meaning they inform us of how each student is doing, and where instruction should begin. We hope to see growth in each of these areas for all students when the tests are administered again in December/January.
