## **COLLEGE IS EXPENSIVE!**

Contact colleges and see if there are any scholarships available on their websites. Look for scholarships on websites like Scholarship Owl and Unigo. Consider different employment options at the schools you're interested in.







## **YOU DON'T HAVE TO WAIT UNTIL COLLEGE TO CONNECT**

If there is a field of study you are interested in, reach out to professionals at schools of interest who specialize in that field. Are there any teachers or counselors at your high school who you would like to build relationships with, or who might be willing to write letters of recommendation?







## **ORGANIZATION IS KEY**

Make a payment plan that includes a budget. Know the deadlines for the programs and scholarships you want to apply for. Create a schedule to keep yourself on track; you can do this on paper, or on free apps like Google Calendar and Notion.
