WHAT ARE YOUR ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL GOALS?

Consider your priorities, and decide whether it would be in your best interest to live close to home or to move away.

What are the benefits to living on-campus versus moving off campus in terms of cost, social life, convenience, etc.?





**WHAT TRANSPORTATION
OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE TO
STUDENTS ON AND OFF CAMPUS?**

Is there a bus or train system widely used by students? How safe and cost-effective is public transportation, as opposed to driving a car, bike or scooter?





HOW IS THE MEAL PLAN AT EACH SCHOOL IN TERMS OF COST AND QUALITY?

What do current students say about the meal plan? Is it saving them money or costing them more? Is the food worth the cost for someone who prefers not to cook?





WHAT IS THE FINANCIAL COMMITMENT TO ATTEND EACH SCHOOL?

Consider costs outside of tuition, including housing, food, transportation, class materials, textbooks, furniture. Budget for any unexpected costs that may come up.
