


- Dolphin HIGHLIGHTS

- School Schedule:
 - 7:40 (first bell); 7:45 (school starts)
 - -2:52 (dismissal)
- Students can enter campus at 7:15 am
- Students will walk through the breakfast line and eat breakfast in their kindergarten quad



SCHOOL PROCEDURES


Parent Drop Off and Pick Up Loop:

- Drop off and pick up your child at the front of the school
- Dismissal Kindergarteners will be dismissed 10 minutes before the 2:52 dismissal bell.

My child is taking the bus to and after school:


- Upon arrival, students will walk from the bus loop to the cafeteria to receive breakfast.
- Students will wear a wristband to identify what bus your child rides (first 2 weeks of school)


Call Lake Forest...955-6710




This June, some entering kindergarten students will be invited to come to summer school at Lake Forest Elementary.

- Student must be registered at Lake Forest to be considered (please fill out our Kinder google doc if interested)




PARENT INVOLVEMENT

HOW TO GET STARTED


Choose Child-Friendly Chores








- 1st Day of School—Separation Anxiety
- Prepare your child in advance. Children will have less anxiety if they know what to expect. Talk to your child about your own positive experiences from your first days of school and also what to expect on their first day of school.
- Allow your child to participate in any back-to-school activities, such as meet the team. Take your child to their classroom and let them explore the room and meet the teacher. Children will feel more comfortable being in a familiar place.
- Allow them to participate in gathering school supplies. Children will feel more excited about school if they are involved in the process of



WHAT TO EXPECT ON THE 1ST DAY

- Routines
- Familiarizing students with the layout of the room
- Tour of the school
- Classroom procedures
- Bathroom procedures
- Snack breaks (am & pm)
- Lunchroom procedures




ON THE 1ST DAY OF SCHOOL

- Walk your child to the classroom (only on the first day)
- Allow your child to put his or her sweater and school supplies away. This fosters a sense of independence.
- Keep your goodbyes short, then leave. Get your goodbye routine down and stick with it everyday. Reassure your child you love them and that you will see them at the end of the day. (On the 2nd day of school you may walk them up to the Kindergarten entry building door, do not enter the building and ensure your student that they will do GREAT!)

AFTER THE 1ST DAY

- Ask your child about their day- tell me 3 things that went well and one thing that was a challenge today. Remember to focus on the positives of the day.
- Recognize that the first day can be stressful because of all of the new people, activities, etc. You may also see a re-occurrence of anxieties after the excitement of the first few days subsides. Reassure your child if he or she is anxious about returning to school.




