Thank you for your interest in Student Government. This is a difficult task to choose only around 30 students out of many very qualified applicants. We, the officers, wanted you to know how the selection process will occur. Applicants will earn a numerical score. The students with the top scores are selected. BHS faculty and staff each receive a form to give you a score of 5 (excellent) to 1(poor) in the categories listed below. The only person who sees these forms is Mrs. Journey. Mrs. Journey takes the teacher input and tabulates these scores as an average – she takes every teacher's scores and divides by how many responses were turned in. This accounts for the majority of your score. Please give a slip to each of your teachers. Please ask them to return them to Mrs. Journey by the due date.

The second part of your total score comes from interviews. You will sign up for an interview after your application is processed through an online calendar. Information for the interview will be via email. Interviews will begin Monday, February 14th (subject to change, will be notified if it happens) in room 4-066. Interview scores come from interviews by the next year's student body officers and an appointed old Student Government member. Interview scores are based on your application, your creativity, your past BHS involvement and enthusiasm. These scores are then tabulated, as the example shows below for Jane Doe. Since so many qualified applicants try out, competition is stiff.

With the self – addressed stamped envelope we receive from you; the new officers will send 8th-11th graders a letter during the week of our Spring Break (March 21st- 25th) informing you of whether or not you have been selected. If you do not get into Student Government this year, please do not be discouraged. We wish we could take all of those interested. If you are an underclassman, work hard and improve your involvement and faculty relations and please try again next year. If you are going to be a senior, the senior class is always in need of students willing to help make the senior year memorable. Key Club is a leadership club that offers community service opportunities.
