There will also be a basket there for dropping off completed Behavior Contracts.

  - **SENIORS - IMPORTANT BRIGHT FUTURES INFORMATION** In order to be eligible for a Bright Futures scholarship all five requirements must be met:
    1. Submit a complete Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), also known as the state application (no later than August 31, 2019)

2. **Complete the required coursework by high school graduation - 5/31/2019**
3. Achieve the required grade point average in the required coursework
4. **Complete the required number of service hours by high school graduation -- 5/31/2019**
5. Achieve the required college entrance exam score (no later than June 30, 2019)
