Tickets are on sale through May 9 and will be sold during both lunch shifts in the SGA room 03-001. If any upperclassmen wishes to bring an underclassmen guest or non-Santa Fe High guest with them to prom, you must pick up a guest form from Mrs. Cain in the front office and have it completed and returned prior to the purchase of the ticket. Tickets will not be sold April 14-April 18. The cost will be \$100 cash for SFHS Juniors and Seniors and \$120 cash for underclassmen and non-SFHS guests starting April 21 and be sold through May 9. The final day to purchase a prom ticket will be Friday, May 9. NO EXCEPTIONS OR REFUNDS! If you wish to bring a date for prom, not from Santa Fe High school, they must complete the form, and they must be 19 or under. You must provide their driver's license number, and date of birth. After the guest has been cleared by administration, you may purchase their ticket for the going price on that date. You must be cleared from the debt list to purchase a ticket.
