If there are fewer than 20 public speakers, each will have three minutes to address the Board. If there are 21 or more speakers, each will have two minutes to address the board. No speaker may transfer their time to another speaker. A digital clock at the front of the room will indicate how much time a speaker has remaining.

Citizen Input is the time for speakers to share their thoughts and ideas about topics relevant to the business of the School Board. Board members generally will not be able to respond, as they can take official action **only** on items legally noticed and listed for action on the agenda. Also, personal attacks and political speeches are not appropriate, nor is Citizen Input the appropriate time to present complaints against individual School Board employees. The School Board chair is responsible for ensuring proper protocols are followed.

*If you wish to read an excerpt from a book during Citizen Input*, under state law you <u>must</u> be the parent of a student currently enrolled in Alachua County Public Schools and have already submitted a formal challenge to the book from which you plan to read.
