Our greatest hope is that IB students like you learn to become responsible global citizens.


The IB Diploma is offered in nearly 6,000 schools in 160 countries.



IB Math Progression

Math allows for many options, depending on your talents and goals for the future. Successful completion of Algebra 1 is a requirement for application to the IB Program. The following shows the general flow of math based on your point of entry.
