

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between the Alachua County Public Schools and the ACEA Collective Bargaining

For the 2022-2023 School Year Negotiations, both parties agree to waive the indicated portion of the Collective Bargaining Agreement Between The School Board of Alachua County and The Alachua County Education Association.


In an effort to expedite the ability of the certified bargaining teams to settle on a salary increase prior to the 2022-2023 School Year, the following right on language reopeners will be waived until negotiations for 2023-2024. That will begin early in October of 2022. Only the stricken language below is waived:

ARTICLE I. TERM OF THE AGREEMENT

Section 1.


This agreement will be effective as of July 1, 2019, and will remain in effect until June 20, ~~2022~~ 2023; with the understanding that mutually agreed upon items, Education Support salary schedule, supplement salary schedule, and fringe benefits will be open to negotiations.

This Memorandum of Understanding dated this 9 day of May, 2022, is solely in place for the 2022-2023 School Year.
